

Breakfast Republic Marches Forward With Fourth Location

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Proving that brunch is boss in San Diego, Breakfast Republic is building on its success in North Park and Liberty Station with a <u>recently-announced location in Encinitas</u>, and now there's intel on another outpost that's headed to the East VillageBack in June, we learned that <u>Zanzibar Cafe was up for grabs</u> after nine years in operation at the corner of G Street and Seventh Avenue. Breakfast Republic will take over the 2,696-square-foot space, which includes a 300-square-foot sidewalk patio.

While the morning-centric eatery will open as soon as next month in Encinitas, owner **Johan Engman** shared that it won't debut in the East Village until February 17.

It will join the rapidly-developing resurgence of new food and drink projects in the neighborhood; **Michael Burton** of Cushman & Wakefield's <u>Urban Strategies Group</u>, who helped facilitate the deal says, "Breakfast Republic is a brilliant addition to the downtown dining scene and exemplifies the continuing flood of quality operators and concepts into the East Village community".
